

Important information regarding appointment at RWG



RWG focusses on the health and safety of employees, customers and relations, as well as business continuity. RWG adheres to the guidelines of the RIVM (Netherlands National Institute for Public Health and the Environment) and the Port Health Authority. RWG has taken a number of measures to minimize the risk of contamination of employees and people present at the terminal of RWG. In addition, RWG has taken measures to ensure business continuity.

You have an appointment at the RWG terminal. We request you take notice of the following questions prior to your arrival to the terminal.

- Have you experienced one or more of the following complaints in the past 24 hours?



Coughing



Nose cold



Fever (38 degrees +)



Shortness of breath

- Are you currently living with someone who has a fever or is short of breath?
- Have you had the Coronavirus or has it been diagnosed in the past 7 days (at a lab)?
- Are you currently living with someone who has the Coronavirus or were you in contact with them while they experienced complaints over the past 14 days?
- Are you currently in quarantine, because you had direct contact with someone who has been diagnosed with the Coronavirus?

Can you answer yes one of these questions? Then we urgently request you cancel your appointment or alter to a digital meeting.

Can you answer no to all questions? Then we look forward to having you at the terminal. We do expect you, just as the RWG employees, to adhere to the general hygiene rules:

- Wash your hands often;
- Cough and sneeze into your elbow;
- Use paper tissues to blow your nose and discard them after use;
- Don't shake hands with others;
- Keep your distance.
